September 14, 2021

- Over 11,000 minutes of reading by kids were logged this year during the Summer Reading program.
- 49 separate programs were offered with 440 people in attendance.
- With the increase of cases, even here in the building, volunteers were suspended for now.
- Many compliments have been given to the number of great books we have on our release shelves, and on the displays we have been creating every month.
- After a hectic summer program, September will be a quiet month with a new program sponsored by the Friends group running in October.
- Our yearly letter requesting funds from the Town has been sent.

Friends report: Future fund raisers were discussed at the September meeting. A quilt is being raffled off to benefit the library. Only 100 tickets will be sold.

Old Business: Discussion of the logo continued with some suggestions about the design.

New Business: Roy Randall made a motion to approve the plan of service presented by NCLS. It was seconded by Bridget Collins, voted upon, and carried.
