June 21, 2022

- New messaging software for local PD will be installed to ensure employee safety
- NCLS annual meeting
 - Asking boards to approve forgiving fines six years and older (by law, we cannot require patrons to pay these)
 - We’re getting a new ILS (Integrated Library System) next year; progress is being made to clean up system before switch
